The Committee discussed the properties that the city owns and if they are buildable or not. Several are in the floodway. Other properties owned by the city could be sold but they are occupied by tenants. City Hall is larger than we need but we would have to find a place to relocate, possibly the lot on Chase and May. The old pool property is in the process of being transferred to Heppner Community Foundation for the mini golf project. Other properties cannot be sold as they are wells, reservoirs, city shops, utility easements etc.

John is working with Morrow County Planning to get the zoning map updated. Some of the County maps do not match the City maps.

The Committee discussed some other properties in town that would be good locations for development. There are several that have vacant houses on them that should be torn down. John will try and get letters out to those property owners by the next meeting. Even if 5 houses became available in town it would make a difference. There are also empty lots in town that can be built on.

The Council will be discussing Ordinance revisions and short-term rentals at the work session this Friday.
